

## Wailea Ekahi Evacuation Plan

It was recommended by the Red Cross that Wailea Owners and Resort guests stay within the Resort as much as possible. Therefore, unless otherwise notified, owners and guests should remain in their home, hotels or condos.

There are four Civil Defense sirens in the Wailea area. In case of a natural disaster, these sirens would sound an "alert," which is a long continuous siren.

Should it become necessary that your location has been notified to evacuate, please follow our evacuation plan. If informed by authorities to do otherwise, please follow their instructions.

## 1) Will someone from Ekahi notify us?

- a. If personnel on property is available, they will assist you with accurate information.
